List and characteristics of the study programme classrooms and their technical equipment with the assignment to learning outcomes and courses (laboratories, design and art studios, studios, workshops, interpreting booths, clinics, priest seminaries, science and technology parks, technology incubators, school enterprises, practice centers, training schools, classroom-training facilities, sports halls, swimming pools, sports grounds).	<p>PdF TU in Trnava has the following premises for the needs of securing the study program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- on Priemyselná Street No. 4 in the building of the faculty headquarters: 1 hall with a capacity of 130 seats, 5 lecture rooms, each with a capacity of about 60 seats, 8 seminar rooms, each with a capacity of about 25 seats</li> <li>- on Hollého street in the university building: 2 lecture room with a capacity of 80 seats, 5 seminar rooms, each with a capacity of about 40 seats. Within the implementation of two projects from EU structural funds, the rooms were provided with laptop, visualizer, LCD TV, interactive whiteboard).</li> </ul> <p>The current equipment of the department that provides the study programme allows students to work in specialized laboratories. An important part of teacher training also includes professional practice at training schools. In recent years, their material equipment has been innovated within several domestic and foreign projects. In addition, the department has two computer rooms at its disposal (e.g., for teaching phonetics and phonology in English).</p>
Characteristics of the study programme information management (access to study literature according to Course information sheets, access to information databases and other information sources, information technologies, etc.):	<p>The University Library of Trnava University is the central library of Trnava University (hereinafter also "TU"). It provides professional library and information services, keeps and bibliographically registers qualifications, bibliographically registers the publishing activities of teachers, researchers and doctoral students of TU, provides library and information services to students, teachers and employees of TU as well as the professional public. It organizes professional events and provides information training. It develops relations with domestic and foreign partners, especially through the exchange of documents. Mutual relations between the library and its users are regulated by the Library and Lending Regulations. The mission, basic tasks and organizational structure are defined by the Organizational Rules of the TU University Library.</p> <p>The profile of the library corresponds to the nature of study fields at TU. The main focus is on library units in the field of humanities and natural sciences. Print library units complement electronic information sources, accessible on the basis of IP addresses TU.</p> <p>The Faculty of Education publishes study literature (textbooks) for students exclusively in an electronic version. Educational materials are stored in the electronic library, which is freely available on the faculty's website: <a href="https://pdf.truni.sk/veda-vyskum?e-kniznica#online">https://pdf.truni.sk/veda-vyskum?e-kniznica#online</a>. A lot of materials are also published in MOODLE courses. This greatly facilitates their accessibility for students. In addition, all departments of the faculty also have their own reference libraries, which also provide students with literature, used mainly in the working on qualification theses.</p>

The faculty has a list of common partner schools that provide qualified professionals, able to participate in providing all types of professional practices to our students.

<p>Characteristics of the possibilities for social, sports, cultural, spiritual and social activities.</p>	<p>The university also creates conditions for its students for regular sports activities. Athletes can choose from: football, volleyball, basketball, futsal, floorball or swimming. Since 2004, it has been organizing Sports Days, the aim of which is competition between students and employees of individual parts of the university. Traditionally, competitions in basketball, volleyball and futsal are held for the TU rector's cup and table tennis tournaments for the master of the university. The best athletes from these competitions represent the university at regular academic competitions in the Slovak Republic or occasional competitions between Slovak universities. In addition, students have the opportunity to sign up for various dance and aerobic classes.
